Swimming Gala

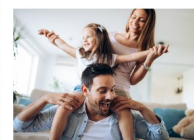
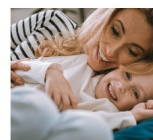
Pupils of Year 5 & 6 took part in the swimming gala at The Venue. A big well done to all who participated, we managed to come third over all.
